



Horse Agility Training and Competition Day

Commencing at 10am with introduction and practice session

Competition to commence around 12 noon

Training

Training will start at 10am with a course walk and outline of the rules and what the judge will be looking for with Chloe Elliston, Horse Agility Accredited Trainer (HAAT). This will be without horses. Followed by a practice session where you can attempt all the obstacles with your horse. Chloe Elliston will be at hand throughout if you have any problem or questions.

Competition

The competitions will consist of an open level class split into two categories; ponies and horses and a liberty class held over the same course.

Entry fees:

HA members - £35 for the day to include tuition and entry into one competition.

Non-Members can choose to pay a one off £5 fee for One Day Membership to Horse Agility (see below). Please note that to join as a day member, you will need to fill in and return the day membership form along with your entry.

Extra Classes at £5 per class.

Multiple horses: Handlers who choose to bring more than one horse may opt to pay £10 for the second horse, but please be aware that only one horse may be in the arena at any one time. If you wish to have both horses in the arena, the full price of £35 will be payable for both horses.

Closing date for entries: Thursday 15th November 2012. (***Entries will be limited***)

All human competitors need to be a member of the Horse Agility Club.

All horses need to be registered with the Horse Agility Club.

It is possible to join and register on the day, however evidence of 3rd party liability insurance that covers the horse and the handler plus the horse's passport **MUST** be presented before starting the day if you are not a full member of the HA Club.

Non- Competitive Entries can be accepted. These are treated just as any other entry and can be judged or not as the competitor wishes, the results are not recorded by the organiser and therefore the Club Office.

What is Horse Agility?

Horse Agility consists of 10 obstacles, plus a control of paces section (at starter level only as of 2012). The obstacles are laid out in an enclosed area. Using a halter/head collar and line (which must be at least 10' long) the handler leads the horse over, through and around the obstacles and their horsemanship/ relationship is scored by an accredited judge. No sticks of any sort are to be used in the competition phase.

No previous experience is necessary but attending courses and play-days affiliated to the Horse Agility Club of Great Britain will prepare you and your horse to play safely while you train.

All handlers must wear hard hats and suitable footwear in all classes.

Example obstacles are:

Backing up down a lane of poles or over a pole

Carry a load

Small jump

Walk through a narrow gap

Walk over a podium

Weaving through cones

Through curtains

Walk over a bridge (First Level Only)

Walk into and through a Trailer (First Level Only)

Rosettes will be awarded to all competitors.

The combined training and competition day is ideal to build confidence in young horses or to introduce horses and handlers to a fun relaxed competition without having to ride.

As safety is a very large part of the training for Horse Agility it will help you and your horse to build a more confident close relationship when working together.

Horse Agility keeps your horse's mind working constructively and it's a great way to meet like minded people who may think the same way about their horse's potential other than as a ridden horse.

Everyone can join in Horse Agility - children and adults of all ages, fitness levels and ability, the people do the training the horse does most of the energetic bit!
