Class 1	40cm Lead rein Dressage test: Walk and Trot Test 2013 SJ and XC in an enclosed arena including a water element
Class 2	40cm Non Lead rein Dressage Test: Walk and Trot Test 2013 SJ and XC in an enclosed arena including a water element
Class 3	50cm Dressage Test: Walk and Trot Test 2013 SJ and XC in an enclosed arena including a water element
Class 4	60cm Dressage Test: Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 SJ and XC in an enclosed arena including a water element

Entry Fees: £25 per class including medical cover. No refunds will be made unless the event is cancelled. Rosettes to 8th Place.

RULES

1. ENTRIES CLOSE on 4th August OR WHEN CLASSES ARE FULL. A waiting list will be kept. **Please check the website for entry status.** No entries taken on the day, other than clear rounds between 9am and 10.30am only.

Riding Times will be posted on <http://branches.pcuk.org/essexhuntnorth/> on Friday 9th August. The course will be available to walk from 2pm Saturday 10th August. In the event of adverse weather conditions, please check the website.

2. The event is run under PC Eventing Rules 2019 Hats must comply with the current Pony Club rules please check www.pcuk.org for details. Hats and body protectors must be worn during the Cross Country. For cross-country riding over fences 80cms high and above, a jockey skull cap must be worn, **with no fixed peak**, peak type extensions or noticeable protuberances above the eyes or to the front and should have an even round or elliptical shape with a smooth or slightly abrasive surface. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used if required. It is also strongly recommended that a jockey skull cap is worn for cross-country riding over lower fences. **All hats must be tagged with an aquamarine PC, BE or RC hat tag. Body protectors must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard. Hats & body protectors will be checked by the secretaries when collecting numbers.** No recording device is permitted (e.g. hat cameras) as they may have a negative effect on the performance of the hat in the event of a fall.
3. Medical armbands are not required as long as a non riding adult accompanies all competitors.
4. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis
5. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

6. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Essex Hunt North Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
7. Competitors who have been eliminated may be allowed to continue over the rest of the course but must give way to following riders, and leave the course immediately if so directed by an official.
8. **No dogs allowed on the day of the competition.** Dogs MUST be kept on a lead when walking the course the day before.
9. Horses/ponies must be 5 years old or over and may only enter one class.
10. Stopwatches are allowed for PC90 and above.

12. The Judge's decision is final. Objections must be made in writing and accompanied by £20 deposit within 20 minutes of the results being displayed. The deposit will only be refunded in the objection is sustained.
13. All horses and ponies must be fully vaccinated against equine flu according to the Pony Club Rules. http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/dcs/Vaccinations_Rule_2019.pdf. Please bring your passport when you collect your number. Spot checks will be carried out.
